

Conhecido por suas pinturas etéreas, Hiroshi Sugito parte de estímulos diversos, que vão de seus próprios gestos a condições climáticas e à rotina diária no ateliê, para criar telas que funcionam como recipientes absorventes do que está fora da imagem. O tempo é um componente essencial de sua prática, já que cada pintura passa por um processo prolongado de reflexão e sedimentação no estúdio, acumulando gradualmente forma e significado. Marcadas por camadas de pigmento e por uma paleta nebulosa e delicada, com tons ácidos, suas obras frequentemente apresentam formas recorrentes que sugerem paisagens ou naturezas-mortas, habitadas por figuras flutuantes que remetem a velas e canoas, casas, construções distorcidas e cortinas. Sugito também incorpora molduras vintage em algumas de suas pinturas, recurso que informa tanto os motivos quanto os elementos pictóricos sobre a tela, conferindo-lhes alusões teatrais. Essa manipulação dos dispositivos de enquadramento, aliada à incorporação de técnicas colagísticas com papel, desafia os usos convencionais de suporte e formato.

Known for his ethereal paintings, Hiroshi Sugito draws from the environment, ranging from his own gestures to the weather and daily studio routines, creating absorptive vessels for what is outside the picture. Time is an essential component of his practice, as each painting undergoes a prolonged process of reflection and sedimentation in the studio, gradually accumulating meaning and form. Defined by layered pigment and a hazy, delicate palette with acidic overtones, his works often feature recurring shapes that suggest landscapes or still lifes, inhabited by floating forms reminiscent of sails and canoes, houses, skewed buildings, and drapery. Sugito also incorporates vintage frames into some of his paintings, a resource that informs both the motifs and painterly elements within the canvas and imbues them with theatrical allusions. This tampering with framing devices and the artist's incorporation of collagistic techniques with paper challenge conventional uses of medium and format.








