espírito jardim humana

Fortes D'Aloia & Gabriel presents *espírito jardim humana*, Tadáskia's first solo exhibition at Carpintaria. Opening on September 14, 2026, in Rio de Janeiro, the exhibition brings together new works that articulate family memory and imagination.

Rooted in a personal cosmology, the works combine abstract forms and organic elements that assume hybrid configurations, somewhere between characters and environments. In paintings on canvas and on sculptural supports made of leather paper, wood veneer, and MDF, the artist develops a lexicon of forms and presences associated with a kind of anima, understood as a force constitutive of her practice. Animals, plants, hair, bark, and other references permeate this repertoire, alongside branches, cattail straw, bromeliads, fruits, vegetables, liquids, and other materials that extend throughout the exhibition space. In her "apparitions," as the artist calls her 35mm photographs, as well as across surfaces, grooves, reliefs, and passages of color, different elements come together between image, matter, and form. What appears in suggested form in the paintings and drawings takes on body and volume in the sculptural works, establishing relationships between different media and processes.

espírito jardim humana also marks a subtle shift in Tadáskia's recent production, characterized by the emergence of areas of white and exposed support. White reappears in the drawings and inside the *cascas*, oil-painted reliefs, as well as in passages where the paint has been scraped away. These areas of emptiness take on a compositional function, introducing intervals of light and openness that alter the rhythm and atmosphere of the works. Around this core, the sculptures bring together found elements and transformed objects, bringing materials of different origins and temporalities into proximity. Graphic marks and fields of color organize surfaces and layers, expanding the relationships between painting, drawing, and sculpture.
